Ethiopian Medium Roast - \$17lb



The Sidama Coffee Farmers Cooperative Union (SCFCU) was founded in 2001 to represent coffee producing cooperatives located throughout the Sidama Zone of Southern Ethiopia. As of 2013, the SCFCU has grown to represent 46 cooperatives and 80,000 farmers, making it the second largest coffee producing cooperative union in Ethiopia.

SWP Dark Roast Decaf - \$16lb



Colombia Supremo 17/18 is sourced from small to medium family-owned farms located within the city of Pereira in the department of Risaralda, Colombia. Producers pick and process coffee at their own micro-wet mills and then dry their own coffee. These beans are decaffeinated using the Swiss Water Process that removes caffeine naturally leaving a coffee that is 99.9% caffeine free!

All Coffee is locally roasted by BD Provisions in our Newtown location in small batches to ensure every bean is roasted to perfection. \$7 of every 1lb bag is going to support the Housatonic Valley Waldorf School
